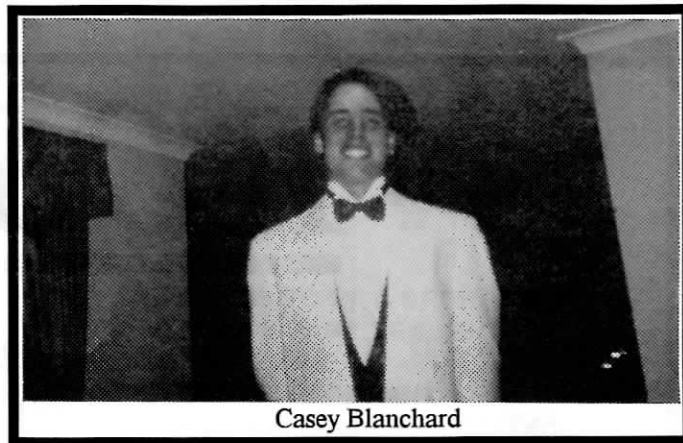

Our club is one of the best about ensuring referees are on duty and it shows in the lack of complaints.

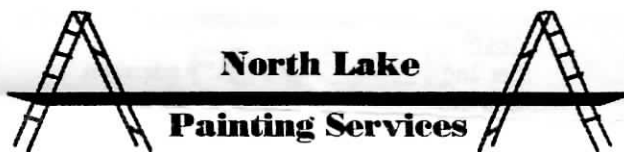
HYUNDAI CHALLENGE

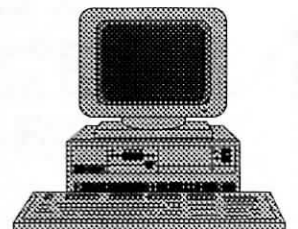

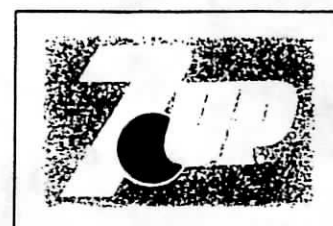
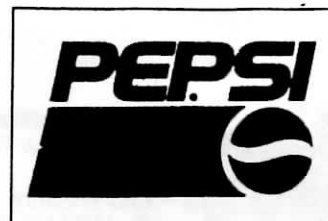
